# The Chipping Sodbury 2013 Classic Run. Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> June

### Invitation and Regulations

The Rotary Club of Chipping Sodbury invites you to enter the Chipping Sodbury Classic Run, a regular major fund raising event. Our 2012 event produced £6250 surplus which was added to our Rotary Charity Account, helping us to continue supporting both national and local groups, individuals and charities.

This year's event will be held on Sunday 30th June and will be just over 80 miles long, starting as usual in Chipping Sodbury's Broad Street, which is expected to be closed to all other traffic. Signing on will be at the **Country Property Agents** in Broad Street. Breakfasts will be available at the **Squire Inn**, Broad Street (by kind permission of the Landlord) - with proceeds going to the R.N.L.I.

For 2013 we have organised a picturesque route mainly in Gloucestershire and utilising roads on both sides of the Severn Valley. The coffee stop at about half distance will be in Newent with the final venue being Old Down Manor, South Gloucestershire, where we will serve pre-ordered ploughman's lunch as well as providing a 'pay' bar. We will again have a large marquee for our lunch venue with parking close by.

The event is open to **pre-1986** cars, motorcycles and light commercial vehicles. The number of entrants will be limited to prevent bunching on the route and to facilitate parking both in the Street before the run and at the coffee stop – so please register early with entry costs maintained at £27.00 per car and £14.00 per motorcycle.

We are again offering a Ploughman's for lunch comprising ham (or a vegetarian quiche), a hunk of cheese, salad and pickles together with crusty bread and butter, followed by an ice cream for dessert for just £8.00. **(Only available if pre-booked and paid for)**. A photograph of each entrant taken during the event will be available at the finish. You are encouraged to wear period costume. An award will be given to the entrants judged most appropriately dressed for the period of their vehicles.

### Regulations

#### Organisation

1. The Chipping Sodbury Classic Run is a Touring Assembly organised by the Rotary Club of Chipping Sodbury ("the organisers"). References in these regulations to the organisers include as appropriate the officials below.  
**THE RUN IS NOT A COMPETITION AND INVOLVES NO COMPETITIVE ELEMENT OF ANY NATURE - NO PRIVATE COMPETITION OF ANY KIND AMONGST ANY ONE OR MORE PARTICIPANTS WILL BE ALLOWED.**

3. Information from entry forms etc will be kept on a password protected database which will be used only for Classic Runs.

#### Eligible Vehicles, Entrants and Drivers

4. **Vehicles** which may be entered are pre-1986 cars, motor cycles or commercial vehicles not exceeding 3 tons.
5. **Entrants** must:
  - (a) Sign the entry form; and
  - (b) Either be the legal owner of the vehicle, or where the vehicle is legally owned by a company, museum, trust or collection, be appointed as its representative.
6. **Drivers** can only be the persons named as driver of the vehicle on the entry form. No one else may drive the vehicle during the event. The driver must observe all relevant road traffic and safety legislation.
